WHAT DAY IS HSTF? This year's festival is being held on Friday, **MARCH 16, 2018**

WHAT IS THE HSTF SCHEDULE? Our exciting schedule will be announced soon, but you can expect performances and monologue competition in the morning, with workshops in the afternoon. The day begins around 8am, and finishes no later than 4pm.
